Development in Play Occupations- Birth to 6 months

Type of Play

Exploratory Play focused on sensorimotor skills

Social play focused on attachment and bonding with parents

Performance Skills

Sensory Organization

- 1. Quiets when picked up or held
- 2. Shows pleasure when touched
- 3. Cuddles
- 4. Listens to voices
- 5. Uses hands and mouth for exploration of objects

Fine Motor Manipulation

- 6. Follows a moving person or an object with eyes
- 7. Develops an accurate reach to objects

- 8. Secures object with hand and brings to mouth
- 9. Transfers objects from hand to hand
- 10. Plays with hands at midline

Gross Motor & Mobility

- 11. Lifts head and raises trunk with laying on stomach
- 12. Sits propped on hands
- 13. Rolls from place to place

Cognitive

- 14. Repeats actions for experiences
- 15. Uses hands and mouth to explore objects
- 16. Searches with eyes for sounds
- 17. Bangs objects on a table
- 18. Begins to integrate information from multiple sensory systems

Social

- 19. Coos, squeals, smiles, laughs
- 20. Expresses discomfort by crying
- 21. Communicates simple emotions by facial expressions
